

JCC–Nampa 2025 Facility PREA Report

In 2023 JCC–Nampa held 61 juveniles. During this period there were 29 reports received:

- 1 substantiated incident (sexual harassment)
- 0 unsubstantiated incident
- 2 unfounded incidents
- 19 Incidents reported which were not PREA (investigated & ruled out)
- 7 Incidents reported which were determined to constitute non-abusive contact

In 2024 JCC–Nampa held 107 juveniles. During this period there were 17 reports received:

- 2 substantiated incidents
- 1 unsubstantiated incident
- 1 unfounded incident
- 7 Incidents reported which were not PREA (investigated & ruled out)
- 6 Incidents reported which were determined to constitute non-abusive contact

Below is the nature of the two substantiated incidents in 2024:

- In both cases, female residents made unwanted contact, or contact that could not legally be consented with, over the clothing to other female residents.

Corrective action plans occur following every substantiated incident, and some unsubstantiated incidents where measures can be taken that can improve safety. Typical corrective action plans include:

- Additional training on supervision practices
 - Increased staff awareness of residents vulnerability & risk to perpetrate screening scores
 - Identification of barriers to adequate supervision and strategies to mitigate
 - Safety contracts for the juveniles
 - Sanctions for juveniles identified to have engaged in sexual misconduct
 - If appropriate, contact with HR and/or law enforcement
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
