2025 JCC-St. Anthony Facility PREA Report

In 2023 JCC-St. Anthony held 146 juveniles. During this period there were 7 reports received:

- 1 Substantiated incident
- 1 Unsubstantiated incident
- 1 Unfounded incident
- 3 Incidents reported which were not PREA (investigated & ruled out)
- 1 Incident reported which was determined to constitute non-abusive contact

In 2024 JCC-St. Anthony held 167 juveniles. During this period there were 9 reports received:

- 2 Substantiated incidents
- 1 Unsubstantiated incident
- 1 Unfounded incident
- 5 Incidents reported which were not PREA (investigated & ruled out)
- 0 Incident reported which was determined to constitute non-abusive contact

The nature of the two substantiated incidents in 2024 is listed below:

- 1 incident of over the clothing hand to buttocks contact.
- 1 incident of under the clothing hand to genital contact.

Corrective action plans occur following every substantiated incident, and some unsubstantiated incidents where measures can be taken that can improve safety. Typical corrective action plans include:

- Additional training on supervision practices, or a change in supervision practices, to include increased supervision efforts
- Identification of barriers to adequate supervision and strategies to mitigate
- Sanctions for juveniles identified to have engaged in sexual misconduct
- If appropriate, contact with HR and/or law enforcement
- Safety Plans that are written and reviewed by the Treatment Team
