Policy

The Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections (IDJC) and Juniper Hills School believes that after school hours should be devoted to other aspects of treatment program.

It is the policy of the IDJC and Juniper Hills School to not assign academic homework, except if approved by the Education Program Manager in conjunction with the treatment team.

Operating Procedures

The Education Program Manager, or designee, and the treatment team will consider the following factors for assigning academic homework outside of school hours:

- Appropriateness of request in regard to combined service plan and learning plan goals and objectives.
- Appropriateness of the request in regard to transition plans and aftercare needs.
